Last week Oliver lead and spoke at our All age interactive service about St Paul, to hear his excellent talk please visit the St Paul's website. Two weeks ago Mark gave our fourth talk in our series on 2 Corinthians...

2 Corinthians chapter 3: 'Metamorphosis.' In verse 18 Paul shows how Christians are being changed from within, like caterpillars being turned into butterflies. They have 'unveiled faces' because the Spirit gives them freedom from the letter of the law. They gaze into the mirror of the Word that reflects Christ rather than themselves. They are in the process of being 'transformed' into the image of Christ (love, joy, peace etc). They may get into the doldrums like the explorer Jason Lewis pedalling his way round the world, but all the time they are making progress even though it may not be apparent. This is all the work of the Spirit, who is the Lord working in them (Philippians 2:12-13). This Spirit is not for a specially gifted few but for all believers. Thus our faith, the word of God and the Spirit of Jesus mesh together like cogwheels to change us from within and bring us nearer to God's ultimate plan for us, which is to be like Christ (1 John 3:2).
