*WEEK 5 DAY 4: Forgiveness*

Jesus answered, 'I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times.' □ When you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive them, so that your Father in heaven may forgive your sins.

If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened; but God has listened and has heard my prayer. □ If we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. □ Therefore let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience.

Blessed is the one whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.

*WEEK 5 DAY 5: Intercession – praying for others*

One of the synagogue rulers, named Jairus, came, and when he saw Jesus, he fell at his feet. He pleaded earnestly with him, 'My little daughter is dying. Please come and put your hands on her so that she will be healed and live.' So Jesus went with him.

Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you.  
□ I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit – fruit that will last – and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you.

*WEEK 5 DAY 6: Pray without ceasing*

Peter was kept in prison, but the church was earnestly praying to God for him. Many people had gathered and were praying. □ Be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.

Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that they should always pray and not give up. □ Pray continually.  
□ Faithful in prayer.
